

CONSENT FORM FOR RESEARCHER

The Corpus of English for Academic and Professional Purposes (CEAPP) is a digital repository of video-based data from university-level ESL, STEM instructional contexts and various types of K-12 settings.

Conditions for data use

To ensure fair, ethical use of the data and sustainable development of CEAPP, individuals wishing to use the data for research and pedagogical purposes must comply with the following conditions:

1. Read and follow the TalkBank **Code of Ethics** (<https://talkbank.org/share/ethics.html>) which deals with issues of respect for participants and contributors and maintenance of confidentiality;
2. Cite and acknowledge CEAPP in all educational and research products (e.g., teaching materials, conference presentations, manuscripts). APA citation should appear as: Corpus of English for Academic and Professional Purposes. (2014). *Corpus of videos and accompanying transcripts from educational contexts*. Unpublished raw data;
3. Share research products (e.g., teaching materials, conference presentations, papers, and abstracts) with CEAPP;
4. Destroy all copies of video-recordings used for any research project upon its completion.
